## Breakfast Club & After-School Club Drop-off & Collection

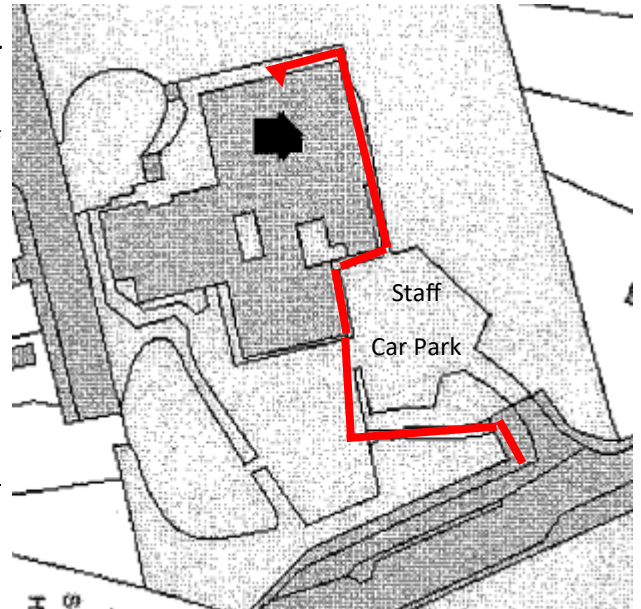
In the Safer Schools meeting this term, drop-off and collection routes for breakfast club and after-school club were discussed.

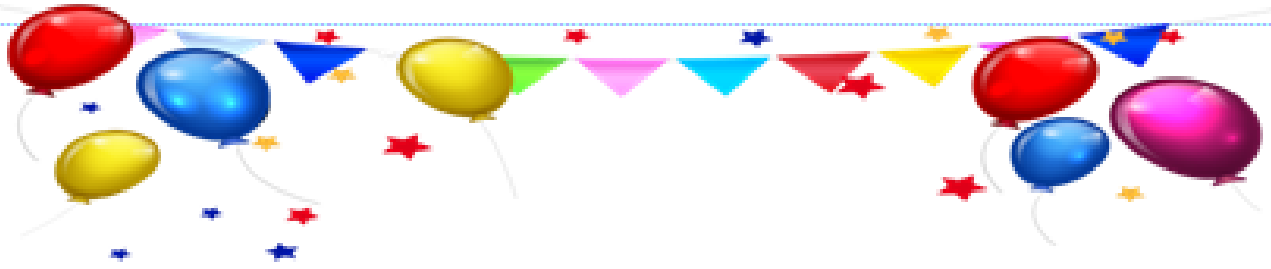

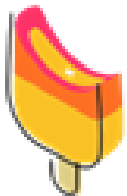
