

Last Supper. Often observed with foot washing, stripping the altar, and overnight prayer vigil.

Friday before Easter. Most solemn day of the church year. Observes the day Jesus was crucified. Observed by praying the stations of Stations of the Cross.

30th March 8.30am Pilgrimage beginning at Holy Trinity Yockleton with coffee and hot cross buns and a short meditative service before setting off at 9.00am for Westbury and Worthen

Saturday before Easter. Observes the day Jesus was in the tomb. This is a day of sombre reflection.


