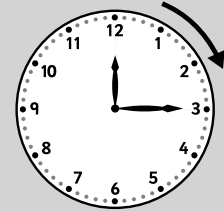

What to do

- In the top three rows, agree with your child what size of turn each animal has made: one quarter, one half, three quarters or whole? Write the answer in each space.
- In the bottom half of the sheet, help your child draw the shape in its new position.
