# Table tennis 10s

Count on in 10s

You will need:

- scissors
- glue

A sequence of table tennis bats arranged in four rows. Each bat has a number on its face and a curved handle. The sequence is as follows:

- Row 1: 0, 10, [empty box], 30, [empty box]
- Row 2: 10, 20, [empty box], 40, [empty box]
- Row 3: 50, [empty box], 70, [empty box], 90
- Row 4: 60, [empty box], 80, [empty box], 100

## Teacher's notes

Children cut out the multiples of 10 table tennis bats at the bottom of the sheet. They stick each one into the correct position in the sequences.
