A small farm—

2 hectares (5 acres) of land

A large farm—

450 hectares (1100 acres)

They grow vegetables including cabbages, onions and peas. Charles also grows coffee and fruit like papaya, mango, avocado and jackfruit. A small number of pigs and cows.

All crops and livestock are sold to consumers.

Coffee beans are shipped abroad. The rest of the harvest and the milk from the cow are used to support the farmer's family.

Some farms don't have a water source and have big issues during dry seasons.

Running water is available but the weather can impact crop growth.

They grow a variety of crops and keep a range of livestock

Nutrients has to be added to the soil and technology is used alongside machinery.

No chemicals or technology is used.
