Songs and activities for the whole family

Instrument family to explore: Percussion. DSO kids (Dallas Symphony Orchestra) – Listen to different percussion instruments <https://www.mydso.com/dso-kids/learn-and-listen/instruments>. Ask your parents to play the examples, once you have listened to them, and see if you can correctly identify the instrument. (Tip: parents you can make this easier by doing a 50/50 ie “Is this a glockenspiel, or is it a castanet?”)

Years 3 – 4
