Singular Possessive Apostrophes

3. Armstrong stepped off the **Eagle's** ladder and onto the **Moon's** surface.

Possessive Plural Nouns

1. The **astronauts'** spacesuits had been especially designed to cope with extreme temperatures while out in space.
