PARENT TIP:

By the end of Y1 your child needs to be able to tell the time to the hour and half hour. By the end of Y2 your child needs to be able to tell the time to the nearest five minutes (including quarter to and quarter past). If they are struggling with time, make sure you test them little and often (get them to tell the time from a clock at home or buy a plastic clock so they can move the hands themselves).
