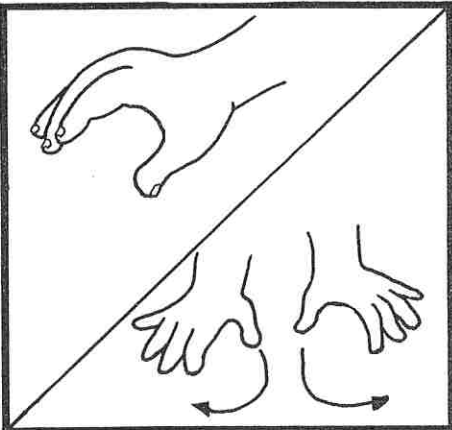

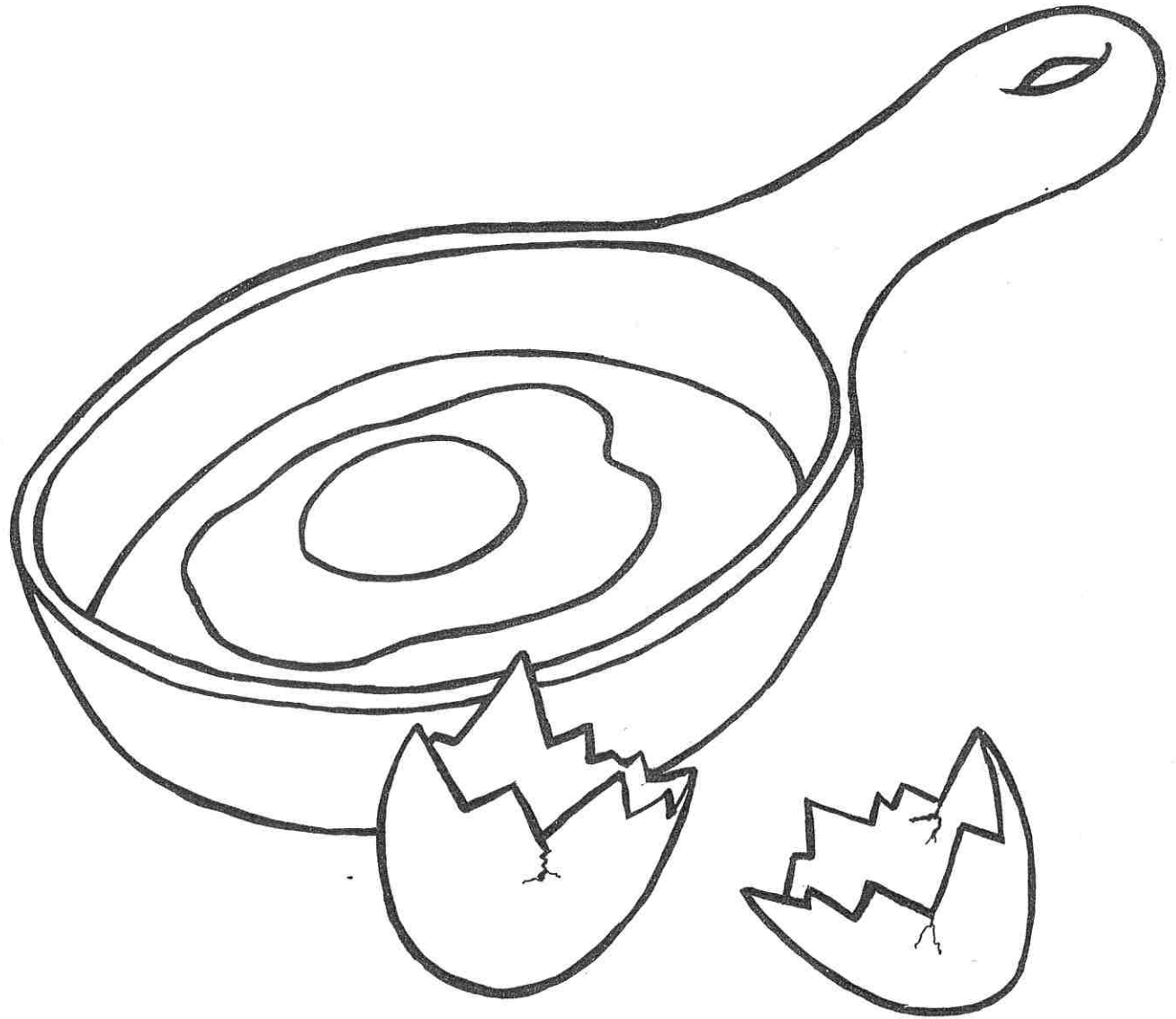


ACTION

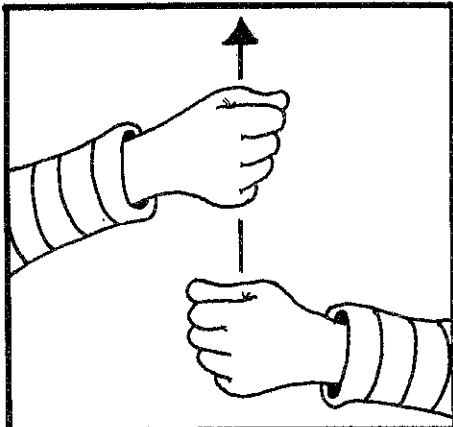

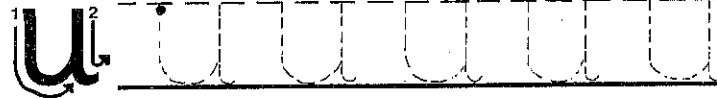

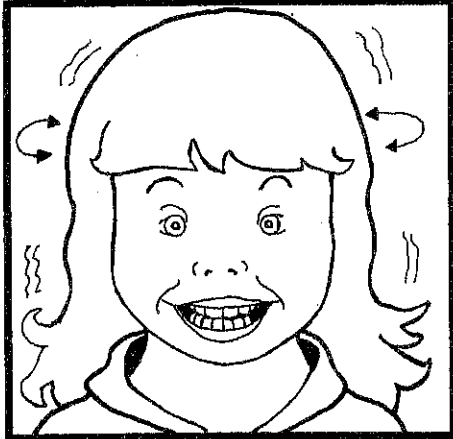
Keep one hand steady and raise the other, as if raising an umbrella, and say *u...u...u...up.*

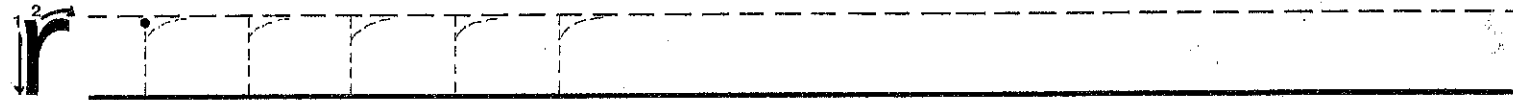

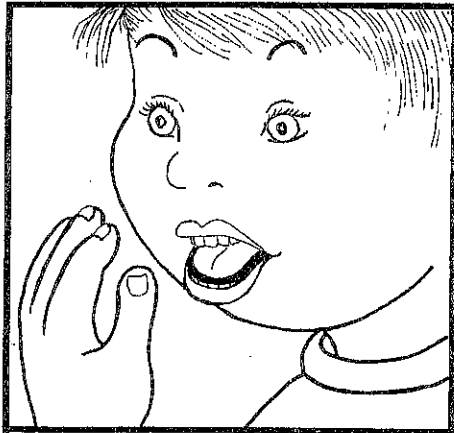
Pretend to be a puppy pulling a rag, with teeth clenched and shaking head, saying *rrrrr*.
